Development of AutoCAD started in September 1981. The

first versions of AutoCAD ran on PDP-11s and VAX computers and were specifically designed for the small-office market.

PARC, the Xerox Palo Alto Research Center, was formed in April 1971 to design and develop the Xerox Alto, a portable computer and operating system that would run applications created in the LISP programming language. By September of that

year, the Alto was fully operational, and PARC was contracted by the Xerox Corporation to develop a desktop version of the Alto to sell to the market. By May 1973, the Alto desk computer was nearing completion and was in the hands of Xerox customers. On July 2, 1973, PARC issued a request for proposal (RFP) to the major computer manufacturers, asking

for the development of a better desktop-oriented CAD program than that available at the time.

AcadDWG is a native Windows toolset that lets you work in DWG format drawings as native

He attended the University of Illinois from 1919 to 1923, earning a B.A. in Architecture. He studied architecture with Edwin W. Hall

of the Chicago firm, Robb & Robb. Milne met Elsie Wright, a painter and interior decorator, and they married in 1927. In 1929 Milne went to work for the Chicago architectural firm, Loeb and Loeb, as their Head Draftsman. He worked there until 1933, when he joined the office of architect Jacob Wrey Mould, who was one of the modernist leaders of Chicago's Midwestern
